 Always mount SKS-wheel guards using the mounting material supplied.


- When mounted correctly, the ESC safety system guarantees the free movement of the wheels. During assembly, it is of the utmost importance to make sure that the ESC adapters are properly aligned. Incorrect alignment may prevent the ESC safety system from being triggered.
- After the ESC safety system has been triggered or the ESC adapters have been damaged, replace the entire product.




Dispose of packaging material in accordance with the applicable national and regional regulations. When disposing of the product, follow the national and regional disposal regulations.

EN . Mounting the mudguard















Place the damping rubber (K) on the clip in the mudguard (A) and audiby engage the stay (D). Note: Pay attention to the alignment (TOP1) of the ESC adapter.



Attach the mudguard with the soft ties (C) to the fork bridge. Trim the protruding ends.














Visual inspection. Check the distance of the mudguard to the front wheel as well as to the freewheel of the wheel.

Please note. Ensure at least 1.5 cm distance between the front wheel and the mudguard. 05 the mudguard.
